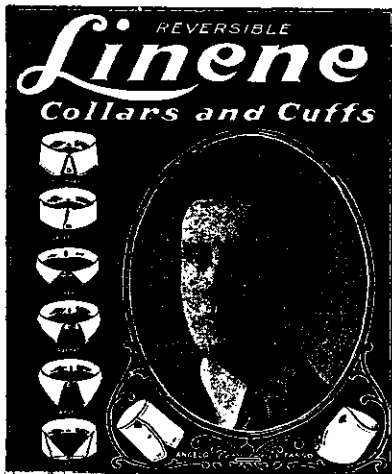

The number of volumes added to the libraries of the Institute during the fiscal year which ended September 30, was 3,099.



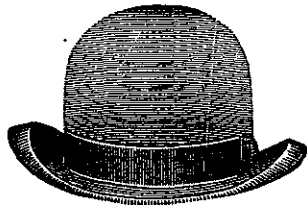
