### The Technical Education.

In a discussion in "The Opportunities in the Electrical Business," a paper presented to the Electrical Section, Western Society of Engineers, Mr. Francis Raymond made this statement:

"It is interesting to note that President James M. Dodge of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers of New York, on December 1, last, allotted to technical graduates an income of only \$650 at the age of 22, \$900 at 24, \$1,350 at 26, \$1,800 at 28, \$2,050 at 30, and \$2,150 at 32. He rated shop trained men at \$675 at 22, \$780 at 24 to 32 years. Trade school men receive \$850 at 22, \$1,000 at 24, \$1,200 at 28, and \$1,250 at 32."

These figures will show at least the financial reasons for securing a technical education.—*State Colleague.*

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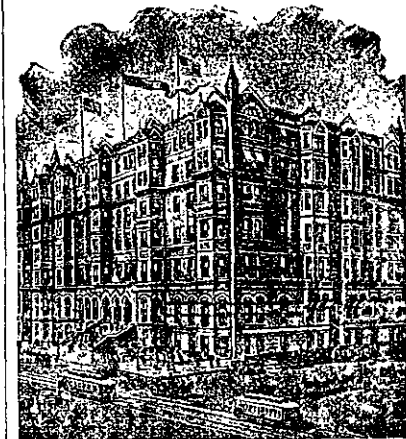
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
