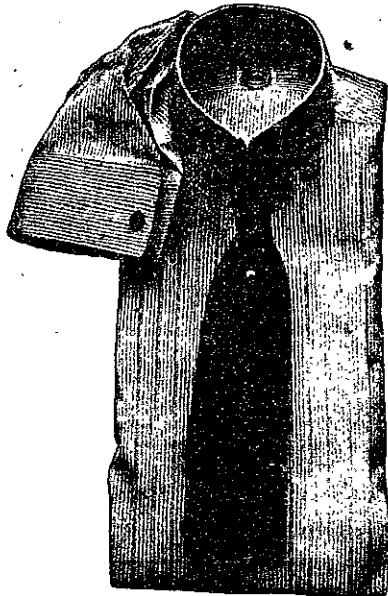

OPINIONS ON FOOTBALL.

President Carroll D. Wright of Clark College, Worcester, Mass., recently said in reference to the proposal to shorten the college course in this country from four years to three, and the effect of such compression upon the student body: "There should be freedom from the exaction and distraction of competitive athletics. There should be a prohibition of competitive games. Such games mean injustice to the large majority of students. Athletics should be conducted for their own sake, for sport and for physical training, and when they are conducted for these purposes—legitimate and laudable—they will assume their proper position in college work of the future."

President Faunce of Brown says that intercollegiate athletics are necessary to bring out the loyalty of a student body. President Elliot of Harvard says that football is not good training for "honorable, generous and efficient service to the community in after life."

Out of thirty college presidents in the middle west, twenty-nine have condemned college athletics. They advise the abolition of football entirely. One of the complaints made is that athletics, as at present conducted, induces gambling.
