From a set of tests made by W. B. W. Howe some years ago, where piles were driven in deep alluvial soil, it was found that with a settlement of from 12 to 15 in. at the last blow of a 2,000-lb. hammer falling 20 ft., the pile could be safely loaded to about 200 lb. per sq. ft. of surface of contact, and, in one instance, where the settlement at the last blow was as much as 26 in., the pile carried, without further settlement during the time it was under observation, a live load of 15,000 lb. In this instance the average diameter of the pile was 10 in. and the depth in the ground 40. ft.

Preferably no cast iron should be used in columns or lintels, but cast-iron columns in no case should be used in buildings more than a few stories in height. When so used, the ratio between the length and diameter of the columns should be much smaller, and the permissible unit stress also much smaller than is now allowed, for instance, by the New York Building Code.


