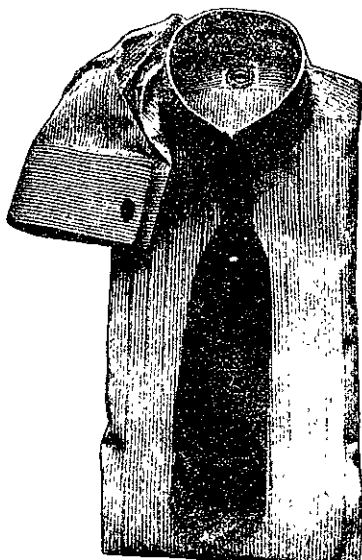

Work has begun on the restoration of St. John's Chapel, in St. Saviour's Church, London, where John Harvard, founder of Harvard University, was christened and the body of his father lies buried. The work is undertaken by Harvard graduates who raised \$12,500 for the purpose.

With a view to determine how much America's educational system has helped establish this country in its commercial and industrial position, Alfred Mosley, the millionaire London publisher and philanthropist, will bring a large party of educators to this country this fall. He will pay all expenses of the trip, which will keep them in the United States three or four months, visiting and studying the schools in the large cities.
