KODAK EXHIBITION.

Many Tech men are taking advantage of the splendid opportunity offered by the Kodak Exhibition to become more familiar with modern practice in the realms of photography. All styles of Kodak picture-making are shown, from the "Man with the Hoe" variety to the lively scenes of the race course and the automobile track. The lantern pictures are of great interest and beauty and are used to illustrate Dr. Dixon's highly entertaining lecture, "Photography as a Hobby."

The exhibition is being held at Copley Hall, and will continue until the 27th of this month. Lectures are given twice daily, at 3 and 8 P.M. Admission is by ticket, furnished gratis by any of the local Kodak dealers.

Yale football coaches are trying to impress upon the members of their team the fact that the honor they hold of being the last eleven in the country to keep their goal line intact, has no bearing on the question of winning the Harvard and Princeton games, which is the only object of a Yale football season. The coaches have told the players, however, that the feat of holding back such elevens as Holy Cross, the Springfield Training School and Pennsylvania State is no empty honor and that the team has shown just such stamina as will be available many times in the big games of the year.
