TO FORM CLUB.

A movement is on foot for the formation of a Boston Club of M. I. T. 1905. So far as is known, this plan is original with 1905 men in Boston and the vicinity and has as object the closer drawing together of all members of the class permanently or temporarily in this neighborhood. The first meeting will be held held on Tuesday, Nov. 6, at 7.15 in the Technology Club. No dinner will be served, but it is hoped that all 1905 men within reach will be on hand to discuss the formation of this club and to arrange the necessary details. Membership in the Technology Club is not a requisite.

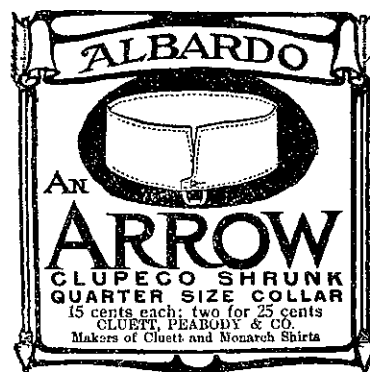
