TEAM IN PENN GAMES

Tech's relay team, composed of Capt. C. W. Gram 1909, A. L. Moses 1910, W. C. Salisbury 1911 and P. D. White 1911, will run this afternoon in the inter-collegiate relay carnival at Philadelphia. These four men, with Coach Kanaly and Manager Fernstrom left for Philadelphia Thursday night.

The meet is run by the University of Pennsylvania and is a model of track management. Everything goes off right on the minute, as with more than 200 teams running and some 40 events to be taken care of, the whole affair is calculated to a nicety. For instance, Tech's race is event 27 and is scheduled for 4:23 P. M. and may be run a few minutes ahead of time. Every man must be on the track, ready for the gun at least 15 minutes before his event is to come off.

Drawings for the position of the teams was made some time ago by a child who has no interest in the meet, and the programs have been out for a week. The order from the pole is: Lafayette College 1, Technology 2, Ohio State University 3, Swarthmore 4, Wesleyan 5 and Ohio Wesleyan 6.

Tech's strongest opponents are Swarthmore and Wesleyan. Last year Wesleyan beat Tech by five yards, with no one else in sight. Tech has beaten Wesleyan indoors since then—"but then you never can tell." The Institute team is in good shape and ought to make a very good showing.
