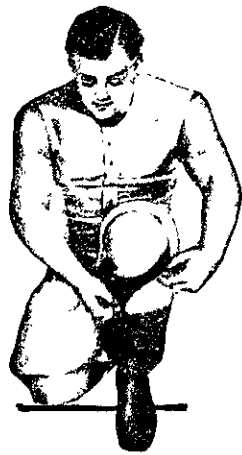

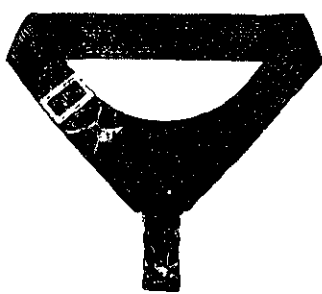

BATTALION INSPECTION

The annual Government inspection of the Technology battalion was held in the South Armory, Wednesday afternoon. After a short preliminary drill, the battalion was drawn up for general inspection by Captain Julius A. Penn of the Seventh U. S. A. Infantry, accompanied by Major Wheeler, Major L. G. Rowe 1910, and Adjutant J. A. Herlihy 1911. Captain Penn is at present with the General's staff in Washington, and was assigned by the Government to inspect and review the battalion. The exercises concluded with a review of the battalion by Captain Penn and Major Wheeler, and further drill by companies.

There will be two more drills this term; the prize drill tonight and regular drill next Wednesday. The companies have been thoroughly drilled in the marchings and the manual of arms, and there is little choice between the companies. The contest is sure to be close, and the competition keen. The old custom of burning the drill gloves in front of Rogers will be celebrated as usual after the drill, especially as Major Wheeler has announced that the absence of gloves at the final drill will be overruled.

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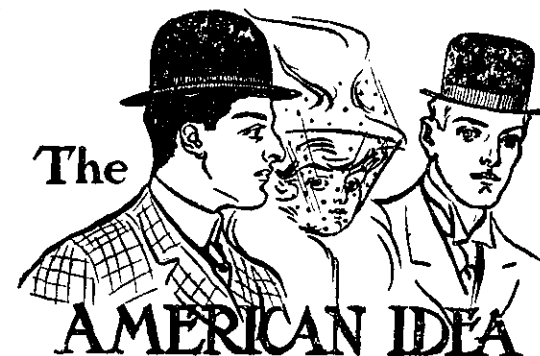
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
