**Sophomores Choose More Editors  
For Yearbook**

According to the constitution of the 1911 Electoral Committee an "art editor and not less than two nor more than five assistants" are to be chosen by competition for positions on the board of Technique 1911.

A meeting of all candidates for these positions will be held Monday, May 24, at 4 o'clock in room 33, Rogers. Plans for the competition will be discussed and work for the summer will be given out.

Technique will be greatly handicapped unless a large amount of drawing is done during the summer. Previous to this year the Art Editor has always been picked before the end of the spring term, and he has been counted upon to get considerable work done during the summer. Long discussions in the meetings of the Electoral Committee have held matters back so long that it has become impossible to elect any man in fair competition to this most important position on the board.

The board must therefore rely upon a large number of drawings done in competition during the summer, so that an editor and several assistants can be appointed early next fall. It is desired
