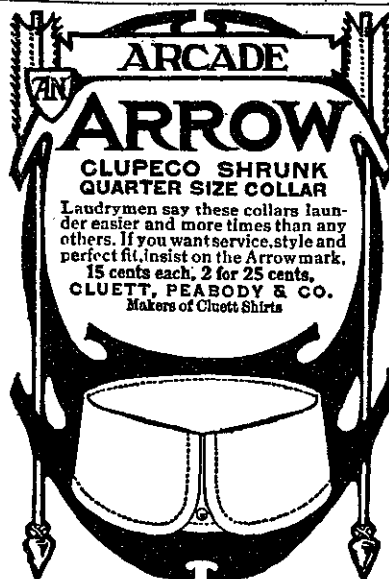
Further information on the subject may be had by leaving a note at the Cage or Show office for the stage manager.

COURSE ON SLIDE RULE.

The course of lectures on the slide rule which is given yearly is to commence today. It will be given by Professor Derr every Tuesday afternoon in the Walker building, from four until five o'clock.

Its object is to give the students facility in the manipulation of the rule, and to enable them to make computation with reasonable accuracy and expedition.

The course includes a short history of calculating machines in general and finishes up with a careful study of the many uses and values of the rule with due regard to practical accuracy.
