### **MECHANICAL LABORATORY**

At the mechanical laboratories, the electric lighting system was put into commission last week. The equipment consists of a Sturtevant 25 KW. direct connected unit, multipolar compound generator, and a Crocker Wheeler balances set enabling the 239 volt power circuit to be cut to a three wire 115 volt system. Lights have been placed at each machine in both Machine Tool and Wood Turning Departments, and overhead in the Forging Laboratory and Wash Room.




