

AT THE STADIUM

Today is a great day in Cambridge and the football eleven will be given a demonstration of how the University and the graduates feel about it. Class secretaries have been sending out post cards to graduates calling upon them to meet in front of Claverly Hall at 3.30 P. M., for a parade to the Stadium. They will be joined by practically the whole undergraduate body and the parade will be one of the most notable demonstrations of its kind ever held in Cambridge. There will be a band and at the Stadium the cheers and songs for the Yale game will be rehearsed. The affair is under the auspices of the Harvard Club of Boston, but every Harvard Graduate is invited to attend the parade, even if he is not a member of the club. This is the first time that an attempt has been made to rally the graduates to the support of the football team, and is another evidence of the great confidence and faith that is felt by all Harvard men in Captain Fish's players. At the field the 'varsity eleven will practise signals in the open, following which there will be a game between the second team and the freshman eleven.



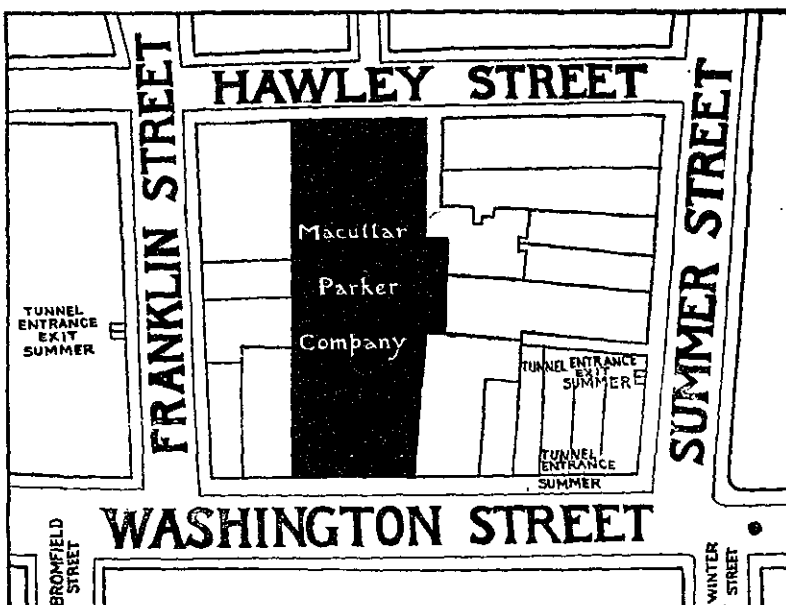
