As the United States membership is necessarily restricted, men have been selected from as wide a range of territory as possible.

These charter members will meet in the clubrooms on Tuesday, March 1st, when the club will be formally organized.

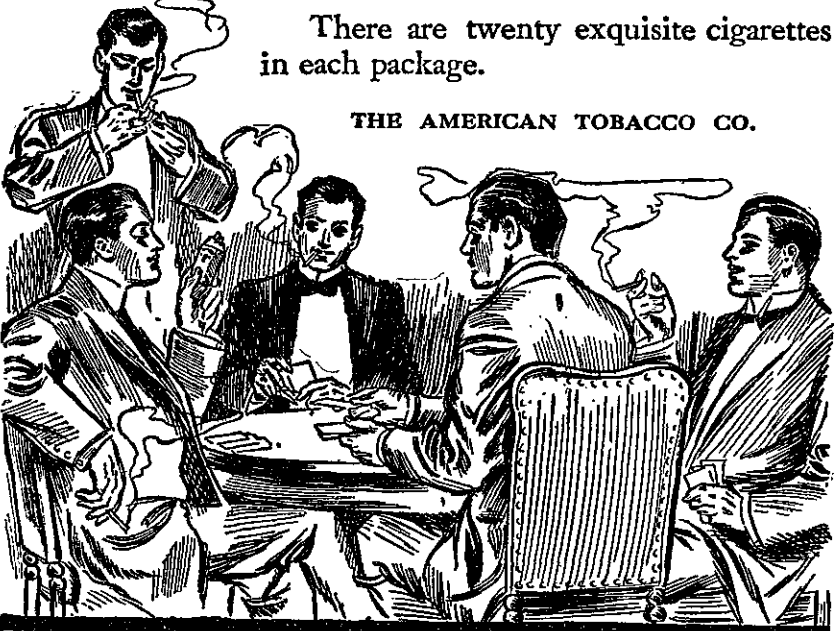
