Pensacola, Fla., April 7.—A speed in excess of thirty-five miles an hour for four consecutive hours was the record made Tuesday in the gulf by the torpedo boat Flusser of the seventh torpedo flotilla. The vessel carried a board of naval officers making a final inspection and speed test of the five new destroyers which recently reached here. The speed is the greatest ever attained by a naval vessel of the United States.

Boston, April 7.—Mayor Fitzgerald has received word that former Mayor Hibbard will accept the offer of the city collectorship. The message was conveyed by a member of Mr. Hibbard's former official cabinet and contained an expression of gratitude for the mayor's kindness. It is understood that the nomination will go to the Civil Service Commissioners with the next batch of appointments.

Guayaquil, Ecuador, April 5.—Serious anti-Peruvian riots occurred during the night. Mobs attacked the Peruvian legation at Quito and the consulate here, tearing down the Peruvian colors and dragging them in the dust. Many Peruvians were assaulted and their property to the value of \$20,000 was destroyed. The rioters demanded war with Peru.
