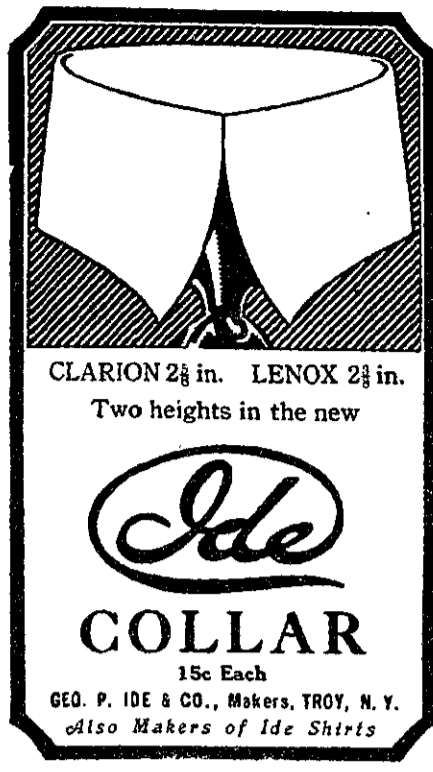

O'HARA TO COMPETE IN CHAMPIONSHIPS
 Track Captain Will Run in New York Saturday Night

The National Committee of the N. E. A. A. U. has selected F. P. O'Hara '17, captain of the Technology track team, to compete in the Senior Indoor Championships of the N. A. A. U., to be held in New York next Saturday evening. O'Hara will run the sixty-yard dash and will be the only Tech man to compete in the championships.
 Competing against the foremost runners of the country at Philadelphia on March 3, in the annual I. C. A. A. A. meet, O'Hara won the 50-yard championship. His time for this event was 5 3-5 seconds. The meet Saturday is to be held in the 22nd Armory in New York and track men claim the track will not be as fast as the one in Philadelphia.

Dr. Tupper, State Immigration Secretary, to Speak Today
 "The Background of the Immigrant" is the subject which Dr. Tupper, State Immigration Secretary, has chosen for his talk in Room 2-147 at 1.30 P. M. today. The object of these talks is to promote the interest of the students in foreigners and to teach students how to handle the laborers sympathetically. At the talk given last Friday by F. H. Rindge on practically the same subject, the fact that business men were continually complaining that college men could not handle laborers was particularly emphasized, and it is for this reason that the T. C. A. has secured such speakers as Dr. Tupper and Mr. Rindge to speak each Friday.
 Dr. Tupper is thoroughly familiar with the situation, having studied in Europe for several years and having lived with the foreigners in their own environment. These talks are very interesting and it is urged that as many students as possible attend them.

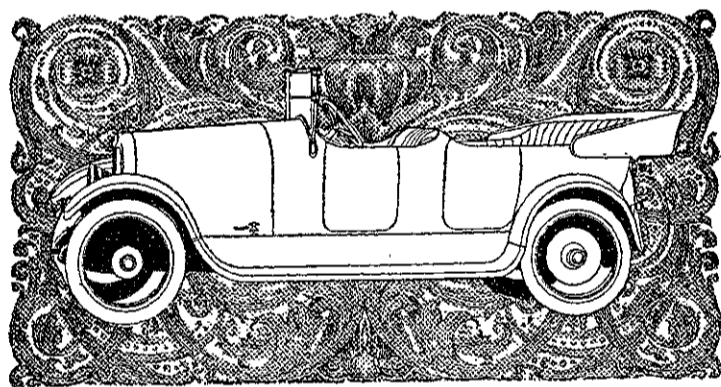

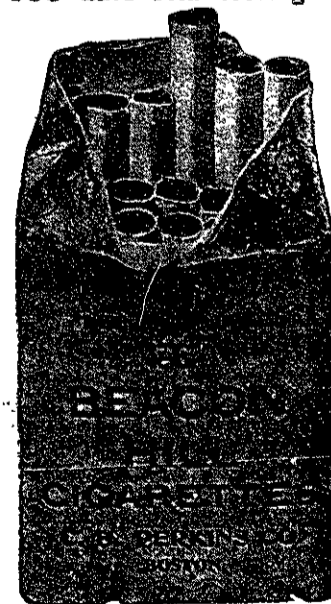
