**INTER-CLASS TRACK MEET COMES APRIL 19**

Contest Promises To Be Close  
—All Winners to Receive Cups—Medals For Second and Third Places

**LARGE ATTENDANCE EXPECTED**

The date of the annual Spring Inter-class Track meet has been set as Friday, April 19 at 10.30. The meet this year promises to be close, as all classes are well represented on the Varsity team. It will also be the first opportunity to see the relative speeds of the freshman and Sophomore relay teams that will meet on Field Day the week following. This meet is usually one of the features of Junior Week, but this year the Inter-collegiate are to be held in the Stadium at Harvard at this time. As quite a number of the Technology team will be entered in this meet it was deemed inadvisable to hold the Spring Meet at the same time.

The Junior class will be represented by such Varsity men as Dorr, Mills, Pierce, and Rollins. Against these the Sophomores will place Bawden, Junod, Scott, and Stone—all men who have proved fast. The freshman contingent will include Allen, Clarke, Purcell and Walton.

Cups will be awarded to all those who capture first places, and T. A. A. Medals will be given for second and third places. The time of the meet and the fact that it comes on a holiday have led the management to hope for an especially large attendance.

**MR. EBERLEIN GIVES LECTURE**

"Italy was forced into the Triple Alliance of 1879 because she was menaced on all sides. Since 1870 there had been a strong clerical influence in France urging the sending of French troops to Italy to restore the temporal power of the Pope. Austria and Russia, encroaching on the Balkans, forced her into the alliance. The secret treaty of Germany and Austria with Russia broke the agreement of the Triple Alliance, and when the treaty was to be

renewed Austria made demands upon Italy which would have been suicidal; but her prime minister saved the land by threatening to expose the secret treaty. Austria has always been ready to harm Italy."

After the lecture many slides were shown of Italy.

Mr. Eberlein said of the Dalmation architecture: "They have combined many architectures in a fine way and with an absence of grossness. Their

decoration is marvelously rich and beautiful and the interpretation of precedent with common sense gives the finest originality." He said that there were now three kinds of architecture: those who know precedent and are willing to use it as a foundation; those who know precedent, but stick so closely to it as to be mere architectural copy-cats; those who don't know it and don't wish to know it and use their poses to hide their ignorance.

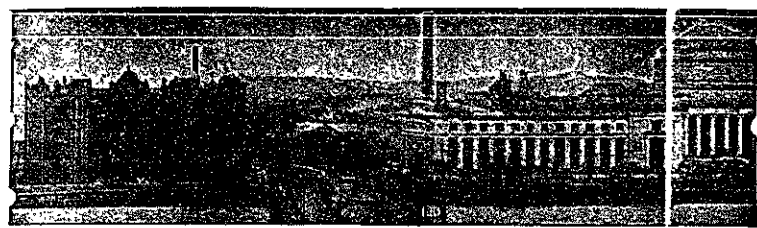
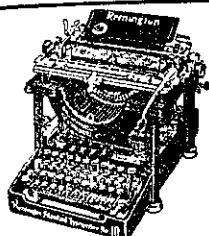
