R. Johnson, dean of the Wharton School of Accounts and Finance of the University of Pennsylvania.

In a preliminary statement sent out by the Clubs it was stated that: "The report of the engineers shows that there is an appalling shortage of trained men for industrial fields and that the universities and colleges, under existing conditions, cannot supply the demands."

"The University of Pennsylvania, Yale, Harvard, Cornell, Columbia, Massachusetts Institute of Technology, Brown, Oregon and Michigan are sending their deans. Herbert C. Hoover will be one of the speakers. Others will include Dr. Samuel P. Capen, director of the American Council on Education; Dr. William H. Walker, director of the division of industrial cooperation and research, Massachusetts Institute of Technology; Dr. R. Bruce Taylor, president of Queen's University, Kingston, Canada; Elisha Lee, vice president of the Pennsylvania Railroad Company; Matthew C. Brush, president of the International Shipbuilding Corporation; Henry M. Waite, vice president of the Lord Construction Company, New York; Louis F. Musil, treasurer of the H. L. Doherty Company, New York; Dr. Merton L. Emerson, of M. I. T., and Dr. Godfrey."


