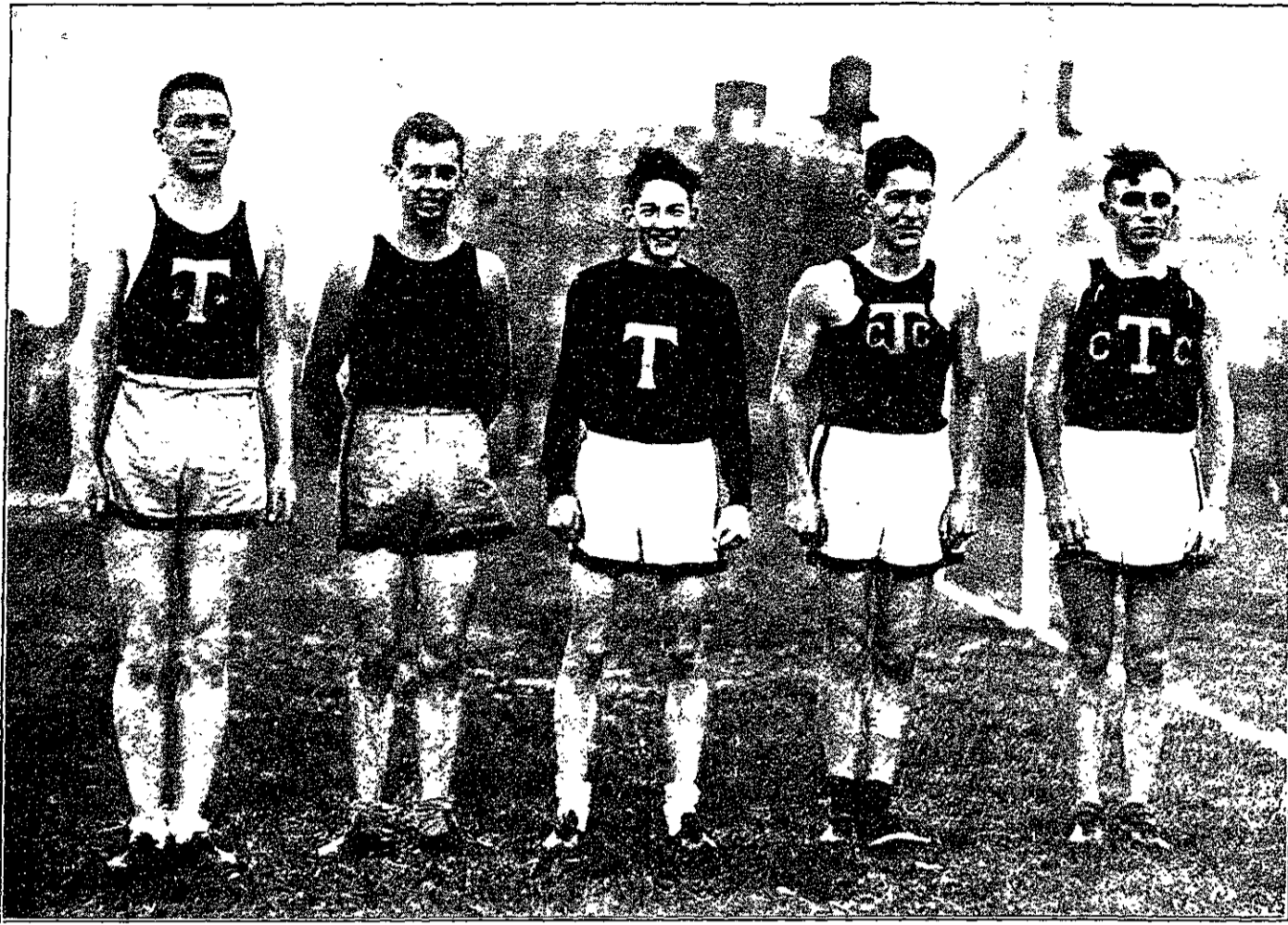




Technology's Cross Country Leader Passing the Four Mile Mark, Well in the Lead, During the Triangular Run a Week Ago.



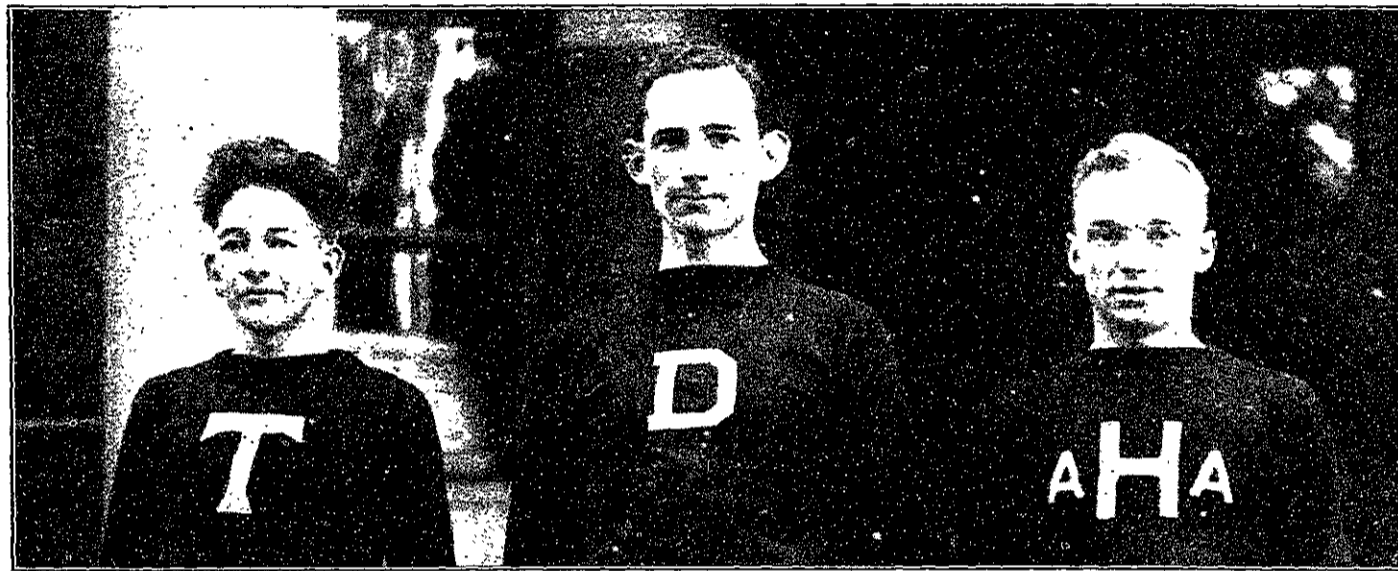

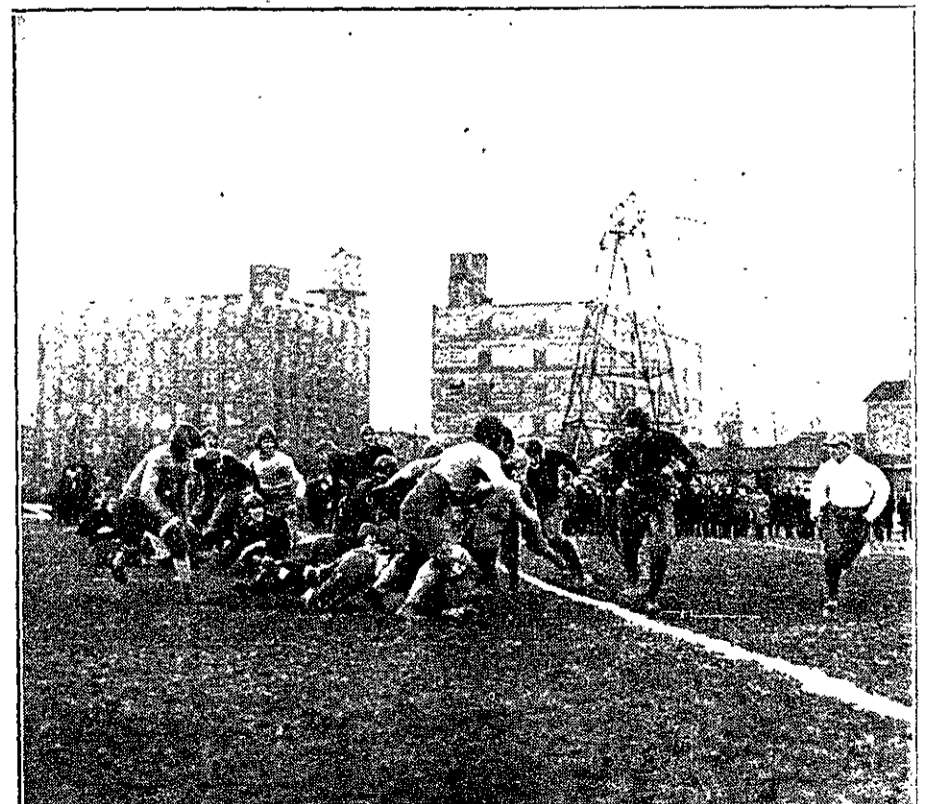
