



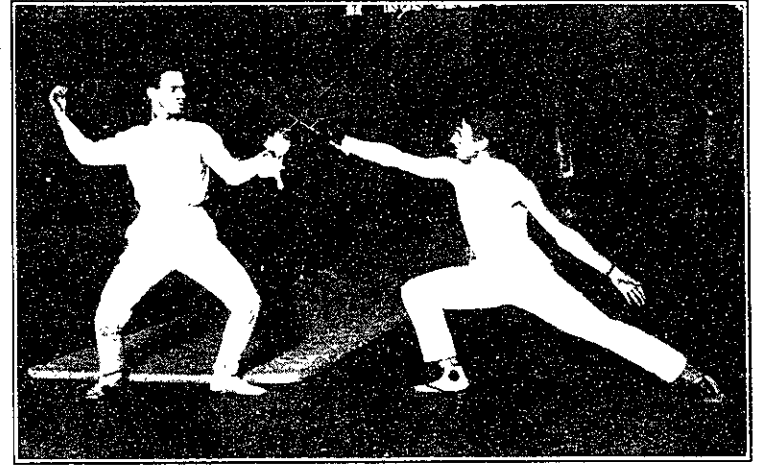

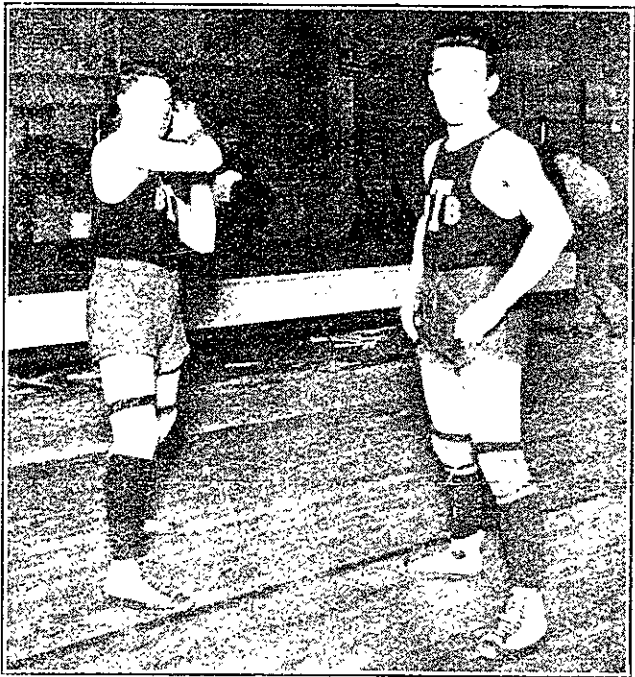

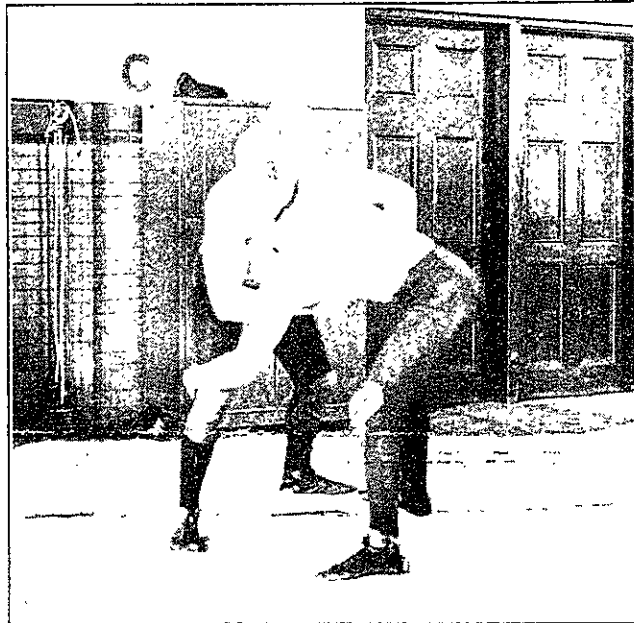

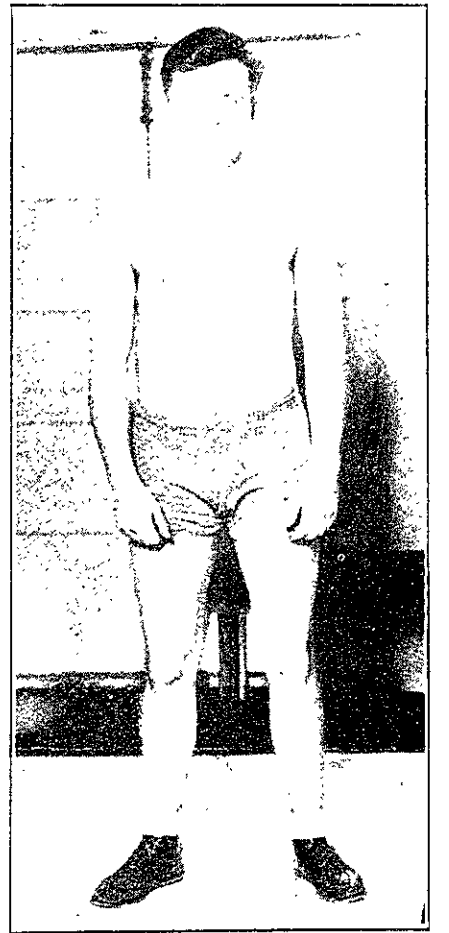

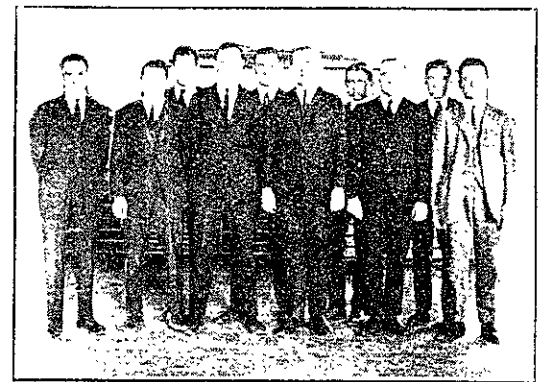

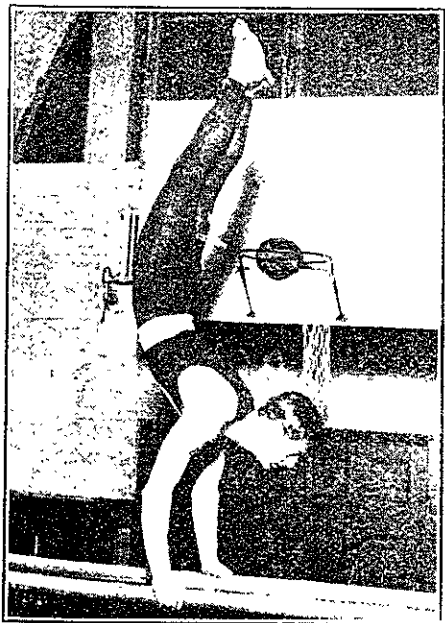

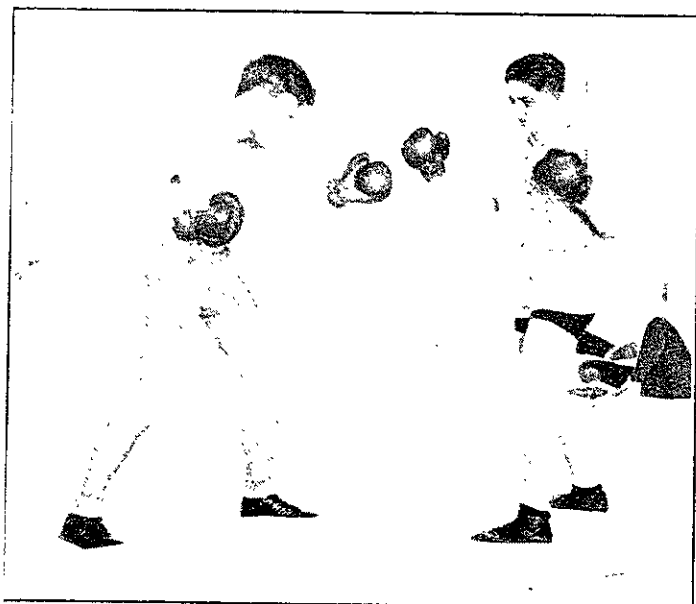

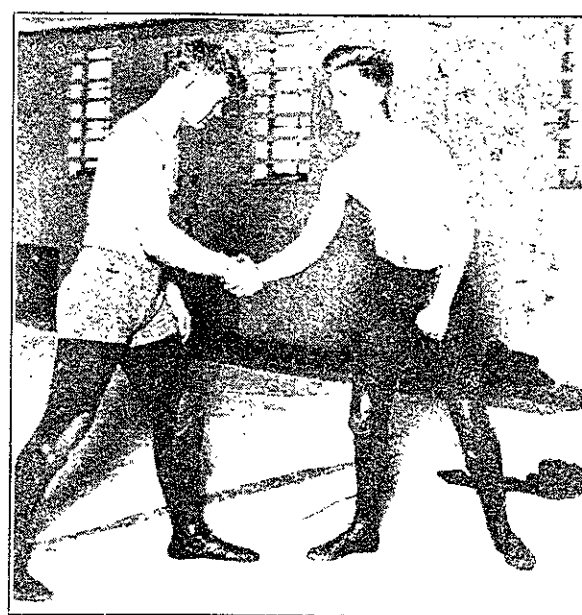
RIFLE TEAM—Last year the Engineers made a fine record and this year's marksmen have started well



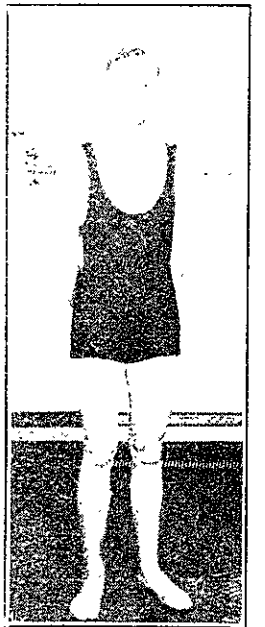
