

### Lehigh Grapplers Win Scrappy Meet

#### Technology Beaten by Pennsylvania Engineers—Bruner Wins

Through starting in the right direction with a five point win by Bruner in the 115-pound class, the Technology wrestling team got sidetracked in its meet with Lehigh at Bethlehem on Saturday, and lost 17-8.

Harry Bruner did his share, beating the brown and white captain to a fall in a little more than six minutes. Rock Hereford scrapped in two classes and after losing the 158 decision came through with three points in the unlimited match. The summary:

In the dorm basketball games last Thursday, Holman beat Atkinson, 60-10; and Runkle defeated Nichols 24-7.

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
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
