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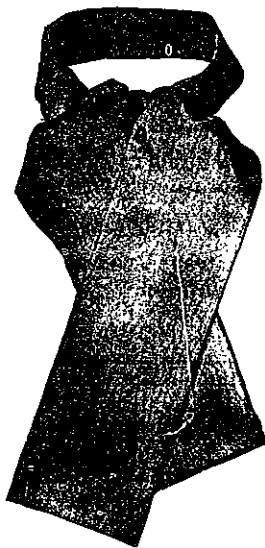

### COLLEGE NOTES.

A movement to raise \$2,500,000 for Princeton University to install a system of tutors or preceptors to enable the teaching of students in small groups, has been inaugurated by the trustees.

Princeton has lost three of her biggest football players, Stannard, Ritter and Holden, through failure to pass their examinations. Five other men, Crawford, Burke, Foulke, Short and King, graduate in June. Unless 1909 brings a number of good men, this looks bad for Princeton's 1905 team.

Harvard expects J. P. Morgan to do much towards raising the alumni fund, of which the maximum estimate is \$10,000,000 and the minimum \$3,000,000.

Yale won the twelfth intercollegiate debate from Princeton, receiving the unanimous decision of the judges. Yale upheld the affirmative of the proposition that "The United States ought not permanently to hold territory it does not intend to admit to Statehood."

The University of Illinois ratified the Freshman eligibility rule, which requires that a student be in the University for at least one semester before he shall be eligible to compete on an athletic team. The fact that it was adopted without hesitation, shows that there was much sentiment in favor of it.

William Jennings Bryan has been chosen by the seniors of the University of Nebraska, to deliver the commencement oration.
