### BIOLOGICAL DEPARTMENT.

a permanent feature of the work of the Department.

Mr. Wm. Lyman Underwood, lecturer in the Biological Department, has recently given his lecture—originally delivered before the Society of Arts—on "Gypsy and Brown Tail Moths and Their Control," illustrated by lantern slides from photographs prepared by himself, in North Andover, Milton, Hyannis, East Dennis, and Willams-town, and is under engagement to speak in various other cities and towns. The rapid spread of these moths has aroused general interest in the subject and an eagerness to learn what ought to be done.

Dr. F. A. Woods has recently published in book form, with Messrs. Henry Holt & Co., his studies on "Mental Heredity in Royalty," upon which he has been engaged for a number of years.

Professor Sedgwick, in connection with the recent tuberculosis exhibit in Lowell, delivered an address in that city on "The Sanitation of the Home, the School, and the Workshop," and more lately, by invitation of the Health Committee of the City Council, addressed a large audience in Richmond, Va., on "The Hygiene and Sanitation of a Modern City." A lecture similar to that in Lowell was also given by him before the school teachers of Taunton.

Prof. Swain will hold his usual reading in 6 Lowell, this afternoon at 4.15. The reading will be extracts from Seneca's *Morals*. The subject last time was "A Character Sketch of Mark Twain" by Robert Barr, which included his very humorous formula for getting a job.
