fever due to an infected storage reservoir, and, although the epidemic is now over, the Water Company naturally desires to take every possible precaution against similar catastrophes in the future.
Acting under the advice of Professor Sedgwick it has accordingly decided to establish a sanitary testing laboratory in which constant supervision may be kept of the chemical and bacteriological condition of the water supply, and Mr. Taylor has been appointed to organize, equip and operate the new laboratory. He has already arrived in Scranton and begun his work.
Mr. Taylor is a graduate in chemistry (under Professor Kinnicutt, M. I. T., '75, the eminent sanitary chemist) of the Worcester Polytechnic Institute, and after serving as assistant in general chemistry for two years at Tech joined the Biological Department last summer as a graduate student.

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
