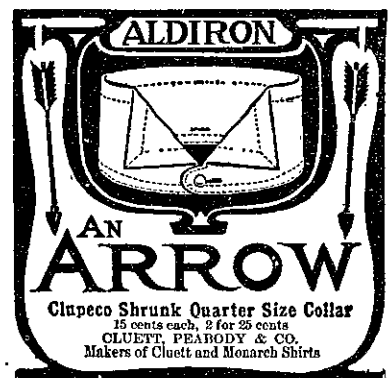
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Broadway & Duane Street, New York**ARCHITECTS AFTER BIG PRIZE.**Nine architects, including two

men who have spent at least two
years at the Institute, one of these
being in the graduate class. The
winner will spend one year in
foreign travel and study, the pro-
gram to be arranged in consulta-
tion with the Department of Arch-
itecture.The problem is to design a home
for army and navy veterans, to be
situated on a large river near a
prominent military station, such as
Fortress Monroe. The architec-
tural feature of the home is to be a
glorious Pantheon, containing mili-
tary and naval trophies, to be
