INTERCOLLEGIATE NEWS

Of the six fraternity house fires at Cornell during the last eleven years, one has occurred in each of the past four years. The financial loss aggregates \$340,997.33. Two of the fires resulted in the sacrifice of human life, eight men being the victims. Most of the fraternity houses at Ithaca are situated upon a hill which is protected from fire by a single inefficient chemical apparatus. In the case of the recent fire in the Delta Upsilon fraternity house, a period of over an hour elapsed between the discovery of the fire and the time when the first effective stream was turned upon the flames.
