

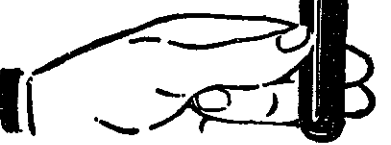

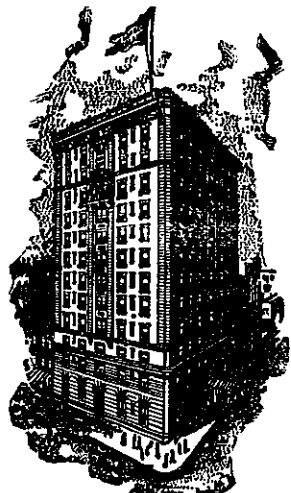

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FOREST AND FLOOD

delay the melting of the snow. This makes the flow of the streams more regular.

It cannot be claimed that forests have any effect on extreme floods. Some of the French scientists attribute the floods of the Seine to the destruction of the forests. A record written by Emperor Julian in 367 A. D. reports the flow of the Seine as very regular.

It is only through the connection between forests and floods that the United States government can legislate on the preservation of forests. The national government cannot go into the states buying up tracts of land for forests, unless it can be shown that the preservation of forests makes the streams more navigable.

This relation is true because the forests diminish floods, which wash down the soil and form sand bars. The fact that forests make the flows more regular aids navigation.

All the European countries, except Holland and Belgium, have recognized the importance of having their mountainsides devoted to forests.

It is true the United States ought to look out for its supply of lumber, for there is three times as much lumber used in a year as is grown.

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
