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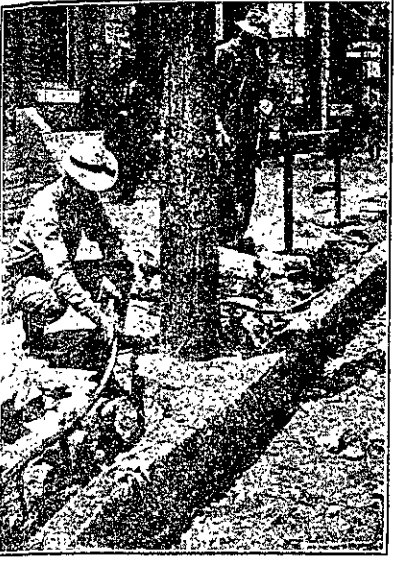
We have had to sift and search

of this year's Show.

The only competition on the Show  
management which closed this spring was  
that for next year's Sophomore publicity  
manager. The competition was won by  
Othnell G. Williams '22. All other com-  
petitions will be continued next year,  
when they will be open to all.

The first act of the new management  
was to issue the call for scenarios for



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next years show. These scenarios should  
contain an outline of the plot, properly  
divided into acts and scenes, with the  
action and musical numbers clearly out-  
lined. The cast of characters should be  
somewhat enlarged upon so that there  
can be no question as to the type of part.  
It is an advantage if part of the first  
act, at least, were written up, and if a  
few of the lyrics were composed, though  
this is by no means requisite.

The Show is to be a musical comedy,  
as in the past and the management wants  
especially to emphasize the comedy. Lack  
of humor has been felt to be the greatest  
drawback to most of the scenarios handed  
in in the past. There are no restric-  
tions as to the type of humor for the  
Show—it may be derived from situation,  
from caricature of some well known  
idea, from anything in fact, except imi-  
tations. While any member of the new  
or old Show management will be glad to  
give and further details or assistance to  
men wishing to write a scenario. Mr.  
Marks of the English Department has  
arranged to meet men who are interested  
at his office, 2-290, today at 12:30  
o'clock. Mr. Marks' long and intimate  
connection with Tech Show, especially  
in the selection and arrangement of  
manuscripts, will prove invaluable to  
men preparing a scenario.

The management also announces the  
opening of the lyric competition. It was  
found this year that the best songs of

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"A Doubtful Medium" were those that  
were not especially connected with the  
plot, such as "Gimme Jim", "Oh What  
a Life!", and "Love's Melody", and con-  
sequently it was decided to open the  
lyric contest at the same time as the  
scenario contest. Comic verses are espe-  
cially desirable. They may be on any  
subject, local or otherwise. Mr. Marks  
will be glad to answer and questions or  
ive and advise in reard to lyrics at  
today's meeting.

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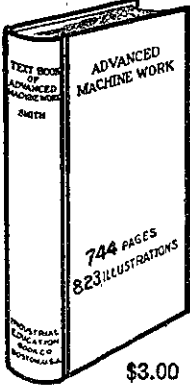

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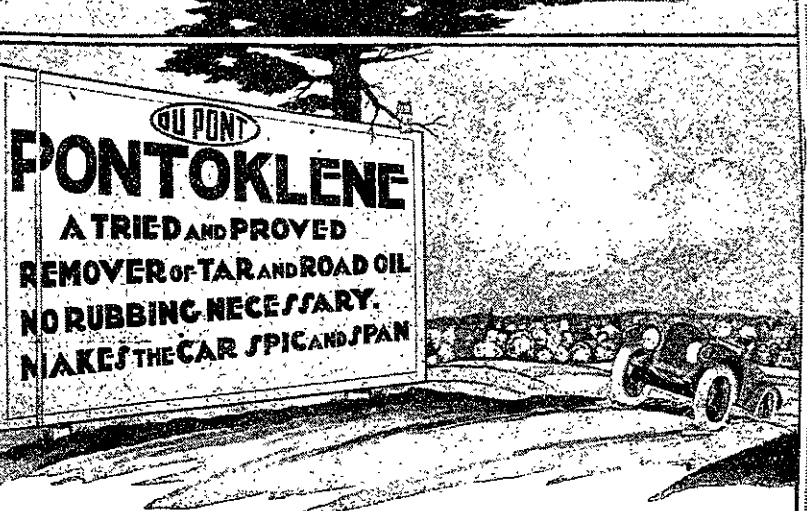
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
