

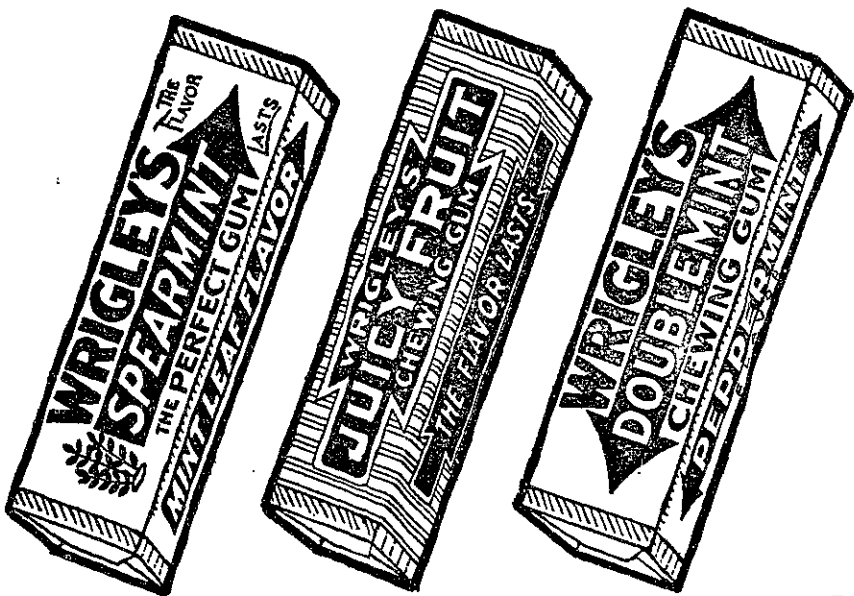
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SOCCER TEAM PLAYS 0-0 TIE WITH STRONG CHINESE TEAM

Technology Men Outplay Opponents—
Team Improves

Technology's Soccer Team played the All-Chinese team of Boston to a 0-0 tie on Saturday afternoon at Tech Field. It was the second meeting of the teams. They played an informal practice game in the early part of the season, which was won by Technology, 1-0.

Captain D. Luykx '23 won the toss and chose the windy side of the field. In the first half, the Institute's representatives clearly outplayed their opponents and only twice did the ball pass midfield on Technology's side of the field. Good work on the part of the Chinese full backs and goal prevented scoring, although several good chances to kick goals were missed. In the second half the Chinese team played a better game. Technology's forwards missed tries for goal which should have been made. Stearns '23 played well at goal and prevented several scores by good playing.

Moller '22, Rue '23, de Macorra '23 and Guimaraes '22 played well for Technology. Huang, Chin and Tsao starred for the Chinese. The team is steadily improving and the management is pleased with the showing against the Chinese team which has beaten colleges in the vicinity and the big preparatory school teams around Boston.
