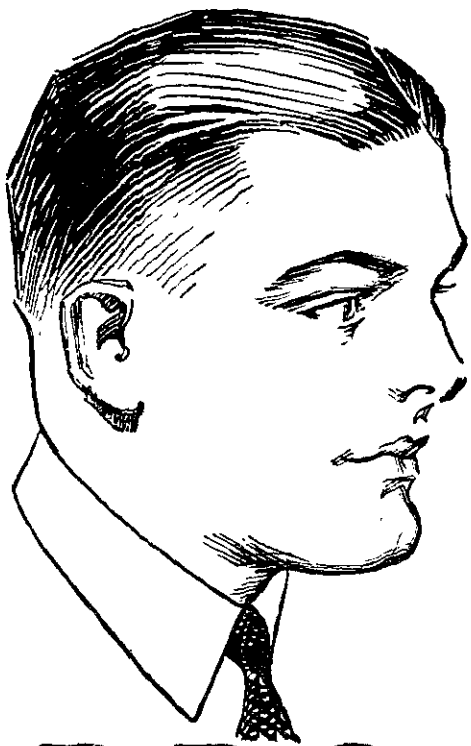




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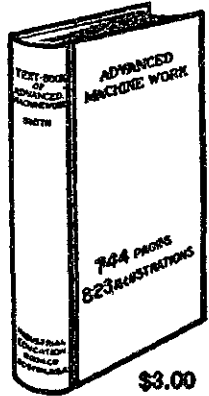
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JAKOBSON TO LEAD VARSITY NEXT YEAR

Since the Walker Library has been closed, a picture of great interest has been put up there. It shows the building where the Institute began

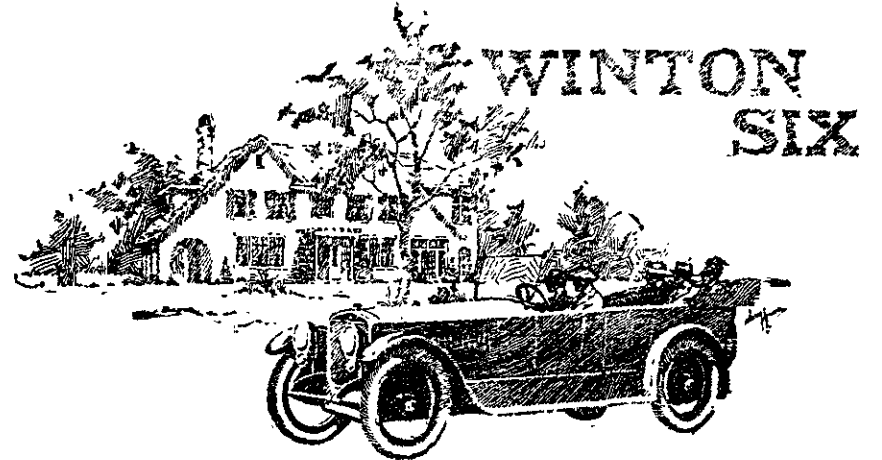
