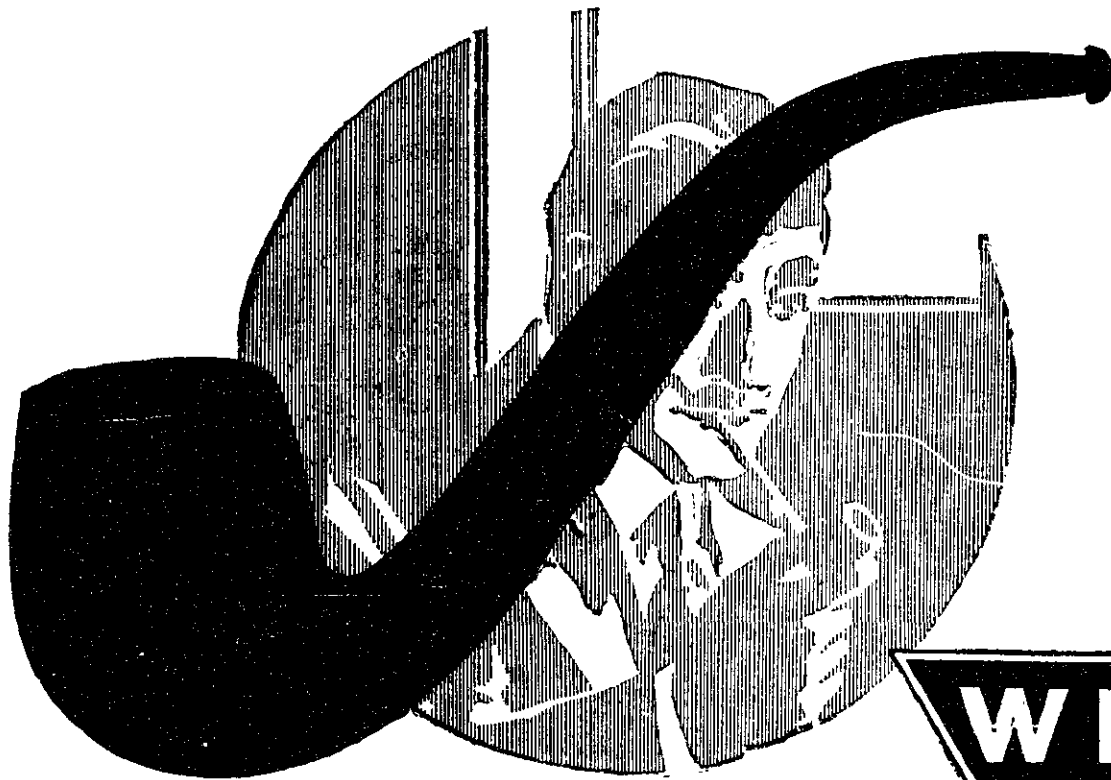
**Cross Country Men Will See Yale
