Delay on Arena Dates Holds Up Hockey Announcement

The hockey schedule can not be definitely arranged until the dates that Technology can play in the Boston Arena are known. Manager Brown of the Arena is now making up his list of attractions but due to the unsettled time of the Arena's opening he cannot assign any dates. However, the hockey management is going right ahead with its plans, for the Arena will certainly be open for our first game about the middle of January.

Manager Brown has suggested that the team practice on his rink at 7 o'clock in the morning. Most of the candidates are not strongly in favor of this procedure and it is doubtful if it will be carried out. If there is ice the team will practice on one of the nearby rinks during vacation. Candidates will find exact vacation plans posted on the bulletin boards.

Last year hockey was reorganized, not having been played at Technology in 1918 and 1919. The team won five games and tied one out of eight. The game with Boston College was the toughest of the season resulting in a 5-4 defeat. Four extra periods failed to break a 7-7 tie with the Yankee Division Club.

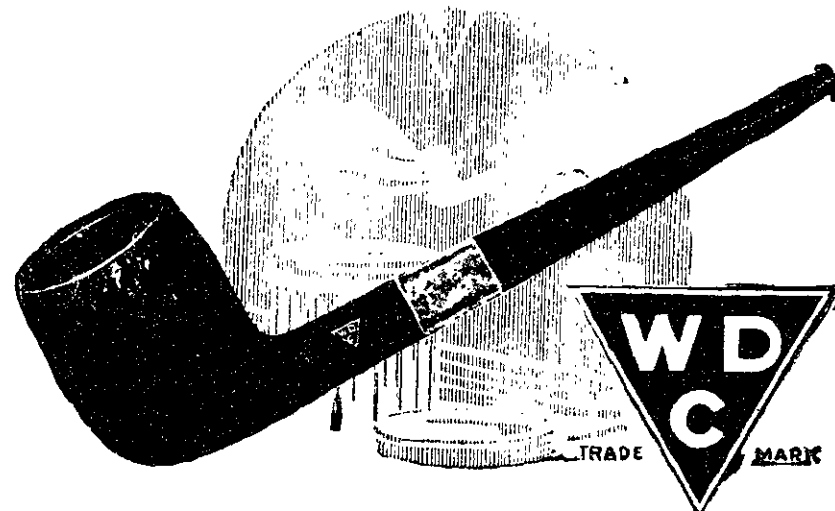
The latest advent in Boston hockey circles is the announcement that
