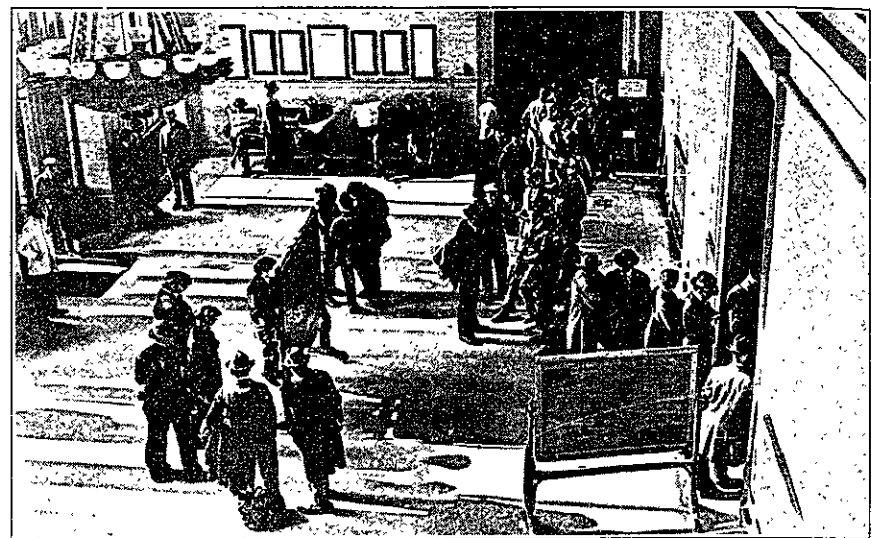
BOOTS WINS!

The finish of his race with Mike Hoar last Field Day. They will race again today, and Mike is determined to wreck vengeance on his heavy opponent.

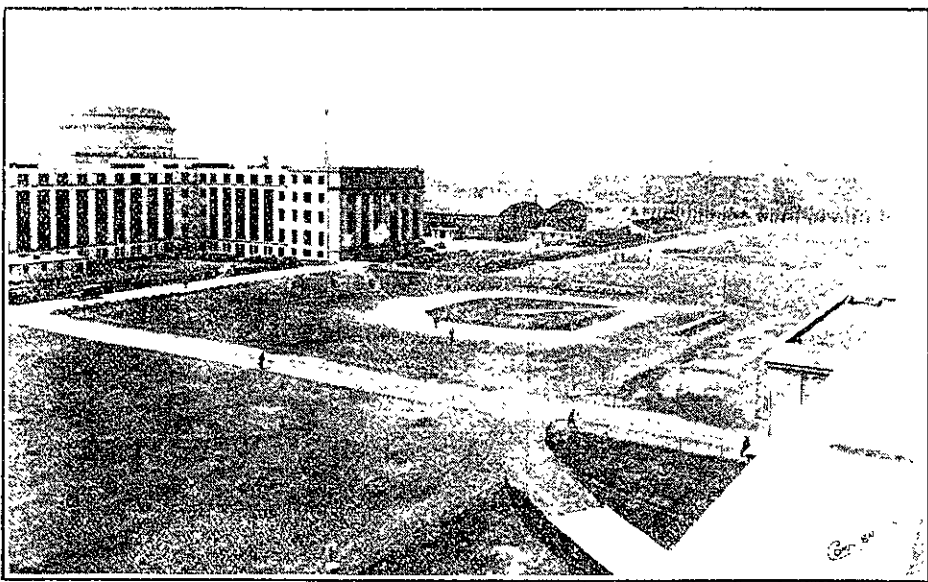


TECH'S MASCOT

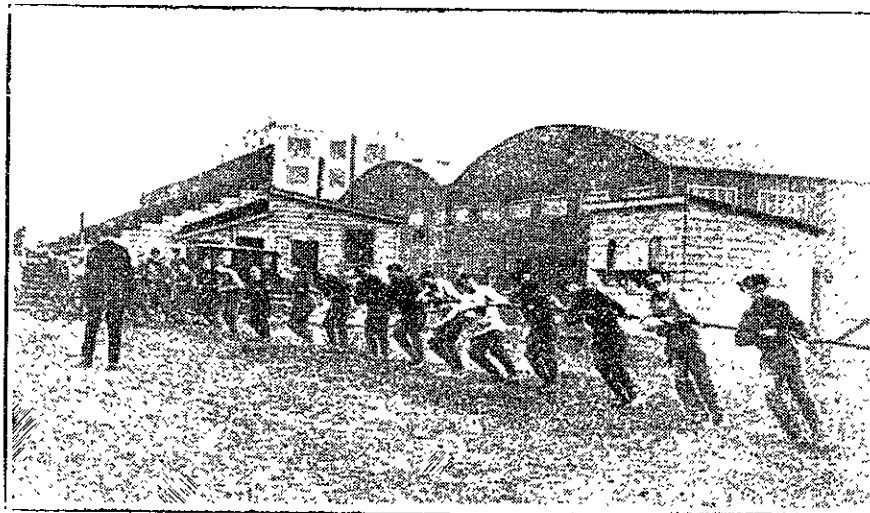

Where the events of Field Day and the Four Class Tug-of-War will take place



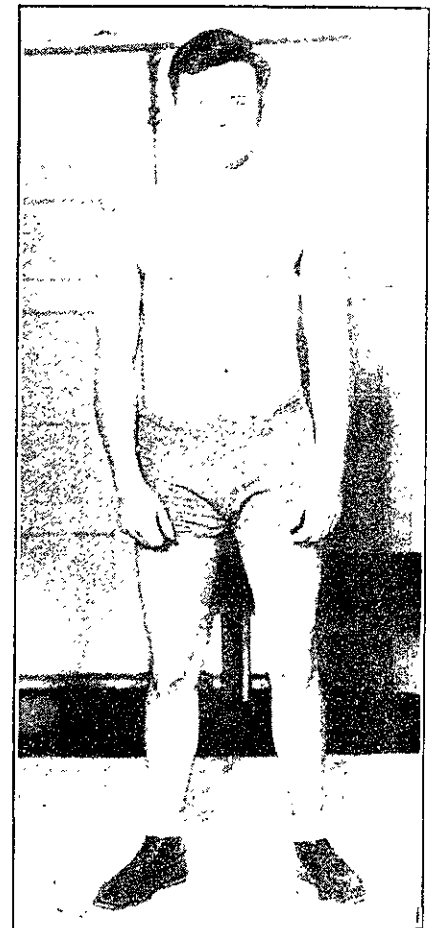

1927 Tug-of-War digging their heels deep at practice



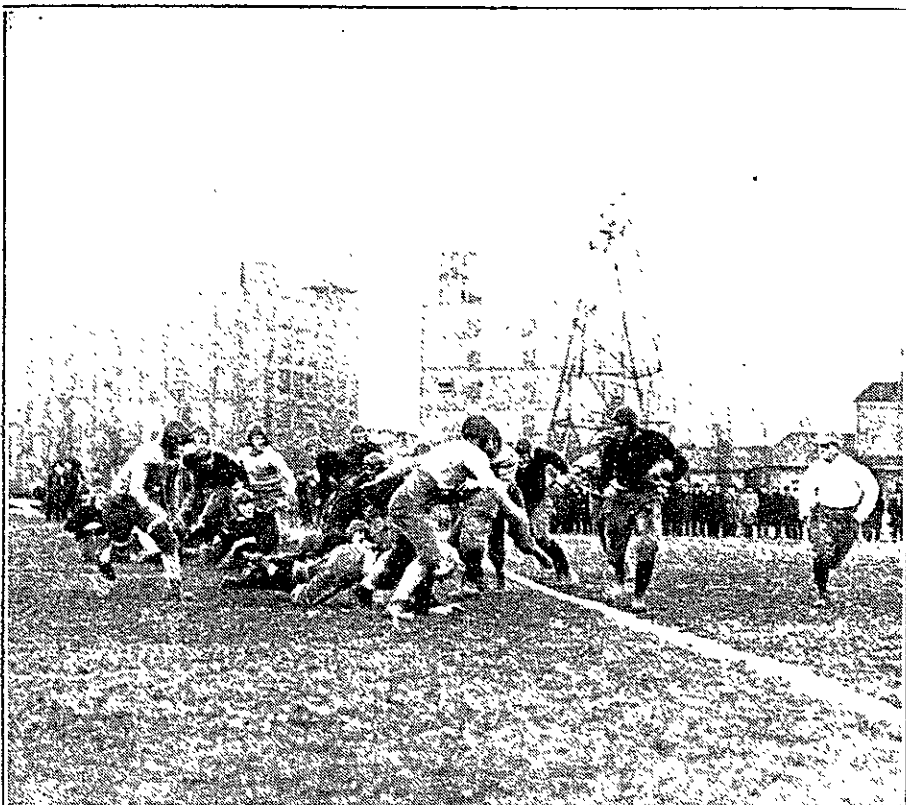
STEADY!

Varsity boxer of known repute and one of this year's Field Day Marshalls. One reason why the Tech Night Committee expects no disturbance this evening.



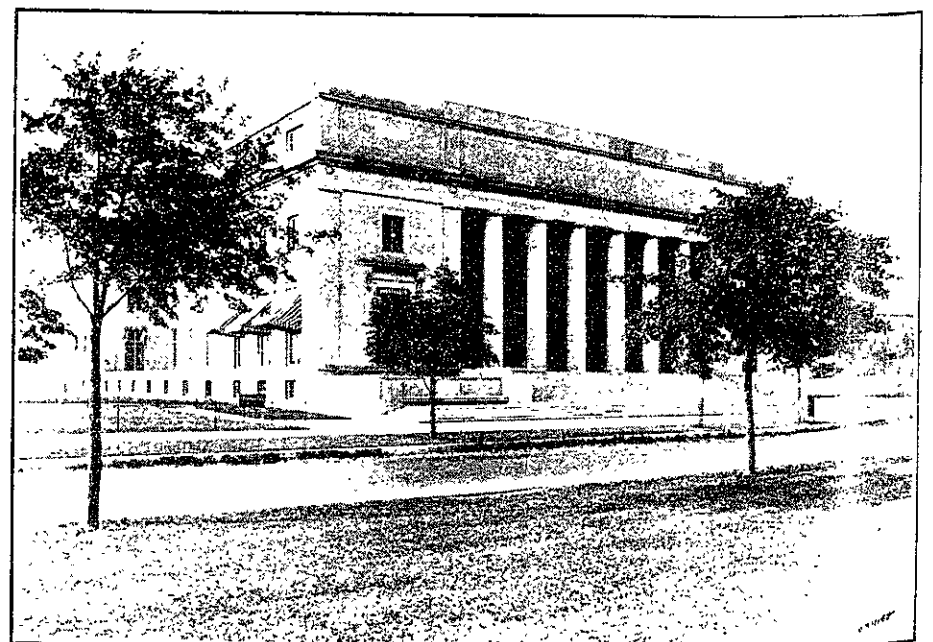
GET HIM!
