FOUNDRY MEN INSPECT WALKER PRATT PLANT

See Details of Stove Making as Part of Course

The men in course 283 have been taking their required trip to the foundry of the Walker Pratt Company in Woburn this week. Groups of men visited the plant Monday, yesterday, and another group will make the trip today. This is an opportunity to inspect one of the most up-to-date foundries of New England. It is a part of the regular course in foundry given at the Institute and all men taking this course are required to attend these trips.

The entire process of making stoves, from the first casting to the assembling of parts is shown to the visitors. When the men arrive they first see the pouring of the metal and then go through the plant in sequence of operation. The inspection takes about three hours and the men are divided into groups and taken through the plant by foundry instructors and by officials of the company.
